Dear Jale,

I delayed replying to your good letter of June 13 until I could be sure that the check I sent to you for \$20,000 was cleared through the Turkish and American banking systems. I now see that it has been and I am therefore in some doubt as to what is your question about it. If there is still a problem, please let me know.

You report a good number of necessary arrangements for the temple restoration and Jean and I are very pleased that the work will now be undertaken under expert technical direction. I hope you will keep me informed as to what is going on.

I think that a proper allocation of the funds that I have sent you thus far should be three-fourths for the work at Side and one-fourth--that is to say \$5,000--for Perge. But if some of your experts and Zeynep can still continue working after the money for their pay has been used, I hope you will keep them at the job and I will remit the necessary extra salaries when you tell me what they are.

My recovery continues so that Jean and I are confident that we will be able to make our projected trip to Turkey. We will leave here about the last week or ten days in August to spend some time in London and arrive in İstanbul the evening of September 1. We would probably want to stay there, at the Hilton as usual, for three or four days before going on to Side. Will you be in İstanbul or Antalya or Side at that time? Please let me know as soon in advance as you can so I can make my plans.


